

Easter Egg Hunt

Every Year since 1989 the Butte Valley FFA has put on an egg hunt for the children in the community. It takes place behind the High school. Children are separated into 4 different categories depending on their ages.

In preparation for the hunt, a few FFA members boil and color real eggs, and others fill plastic eggs with jellybeans. We also mark a certain number of eggs with (FFA) in black marker. When a child finds this, they get a chocolate bunny! Although, each child can only receive one bunny.
